



Welcome to Camp Barrabadeen

Barrabadeen Campsite is operated by Scouts Australia, catering primarily to the Scouting and Guiding movements in North QLD. We have over 50 years experience running programs for youth on the Atherton Tablelands and our organisation has over 100 years providing youth programs throughout the world.

Our aim is to provide quality activities to schools, community groups, and families through outdoor education programs and conferences, which develop leadership, teamwork and personal growth, using the outdoors as the classroom.

This campsite is operated solely by unpaid volunteers; therefore, your cooperation is appreciated. All fees raised contribute to the cost of maintaining the campsite and providing for the development of all youth members.

All campers/visitors are expected to behave in a considerate and courteous manner and to ensure all campsites and facilities are kept clean. All users of the site and their visitors are expected to behave in a manner that supports the values of Scouting.

Please familiarise yourself with the following guidelines:

Check In and Check Out:

Check in time is 2pm and check out is 10am.

Extension to these times are available on request and availability. Please ask the office. Day Pass rates may apply.

Day Visitors:

A Day Pass is available for those not staying overnight. Fees apply - please see office or Caretaker.

Speed Limit:

Walking pace - 10 km/hr.

No dirt/trail bikes or quads permitted.

Firearms:

Firearms are not permitted anywhere on Camp Barrabadeen.

Rubbish and Recycling:

All general rubbish to be bagged and placed in a green lid wheelie bin. Recycle bins yellow lids can take cans, glass, cardboard, steel and plastic bottles only and NO plastic bags.

No cling film, ceramics, food scraps or household waste to go in recycle bins.

Amenities:

- Children under 8 must be accompanied by an adult while using amenities.

- Mops/Brooms are in each block, please clean up after yourselves.

- Campsite toilets are composting type. Human waste and paper only.

- Baby nappies, sanitary pads, cans, bottles etc. are not to be placed into the composting toilets. Please use bins provided.

Private Chemical Toilets:

Not to be emptied into any toilets on site. Dump point is located at Tableland Regional Council Sewerage Works, Grove St Atherton (open 9am-4pm weekdays).

Low Ropes Activity Area:

Located behind the Byrnes Shelter at the Point (near dorms) is **out of bounds to ALL campers and visitors**, unless being used under qualified staff supervision.Continued on Back

Problems and Disturbances:

Please report any issues immediately to the Caretaker.

Your presence is at the discretion of the onsite Caretaker, Groundsman and/or Scouts Australia. All persons failing to comply with the Rules of this campsite may be requested to leave. The use of these facilities is a privilege.

No refunds will be given.

Thank you for your continued support and respect of this campsite and your fellow campers.

Behaviour:

No noise after 10pm. Please consider others always. Camp only on the sites allocated to you. Make sure your camp/vehicle does not encroach onto your neighbours site.

Alcohol:

Consumption to be restricted to your campsite area. Please refrain from consuming alcohol in the proximity of any youth (School/Scout/Guide) activities. Responsible consumption of alcohol is to be observed by all campers/visitors.

Generators:

"Silent" inverter type only to be used on personal sites. Running time is between 9:00am and 7:30pm only

Barrabadeen Camp Power:

Lights around the campsite will go on for 2 hours from sunset until approx. 8:30pm. Toilet led lights are on all night.

Fires:

Gas cookers are permitted.

Gas bottles are not available onsite.

Nearest refills available at Tinaroo Caravan Park.

Ground Fires are not permitted.

Please use fire drums provided.

Extinguish all fires with water.

If available, ground deadwood on campsite areas may be used as firewood for cooking fires.

Please BYO tools for cutting firewood and wood for larger campsites.

Flora and Fauna

• NO DOGS ALLOWED

- Wildlife - we have wallabies, bettongs, possums, goannas, snakes and many species of birds. They are all protected. Please do NOT feed any animals.

- All living/standing timber is protected. Do not chop any living/standing tree, small or large. Restitution for any damage to trees will be applicable.

- Stakes protecting young trees are NOT to be removed.

Emergencies:

- Please report emergencies immediately to Caretaker.

- Any incident involving injury to campers/visitors must be reported ASAP to Caretaker, and an incident form completed with full details of person (s) involved. Ph 07 4091 4387.
- A telephone for emergencies is available at Caretakers office. Dial 000 - location address is RN116 Danbulla Rd Tinaroo via Atherton QLD 4883.

- In an emergency, please assemble at the Evacuation Assembly Point in the main car park behind the Office

The Point:

Is the area south of the bunkhouse/dormitories. No camping permitted in this area - Exception - self-contained motor homes that utilise their own shower and toilet - however this is at the discretion of the Caretaker.

Foreshore:

No fires or tents below tree line (sun shelters excepted for day use only). No parking below tree line.

Boating:

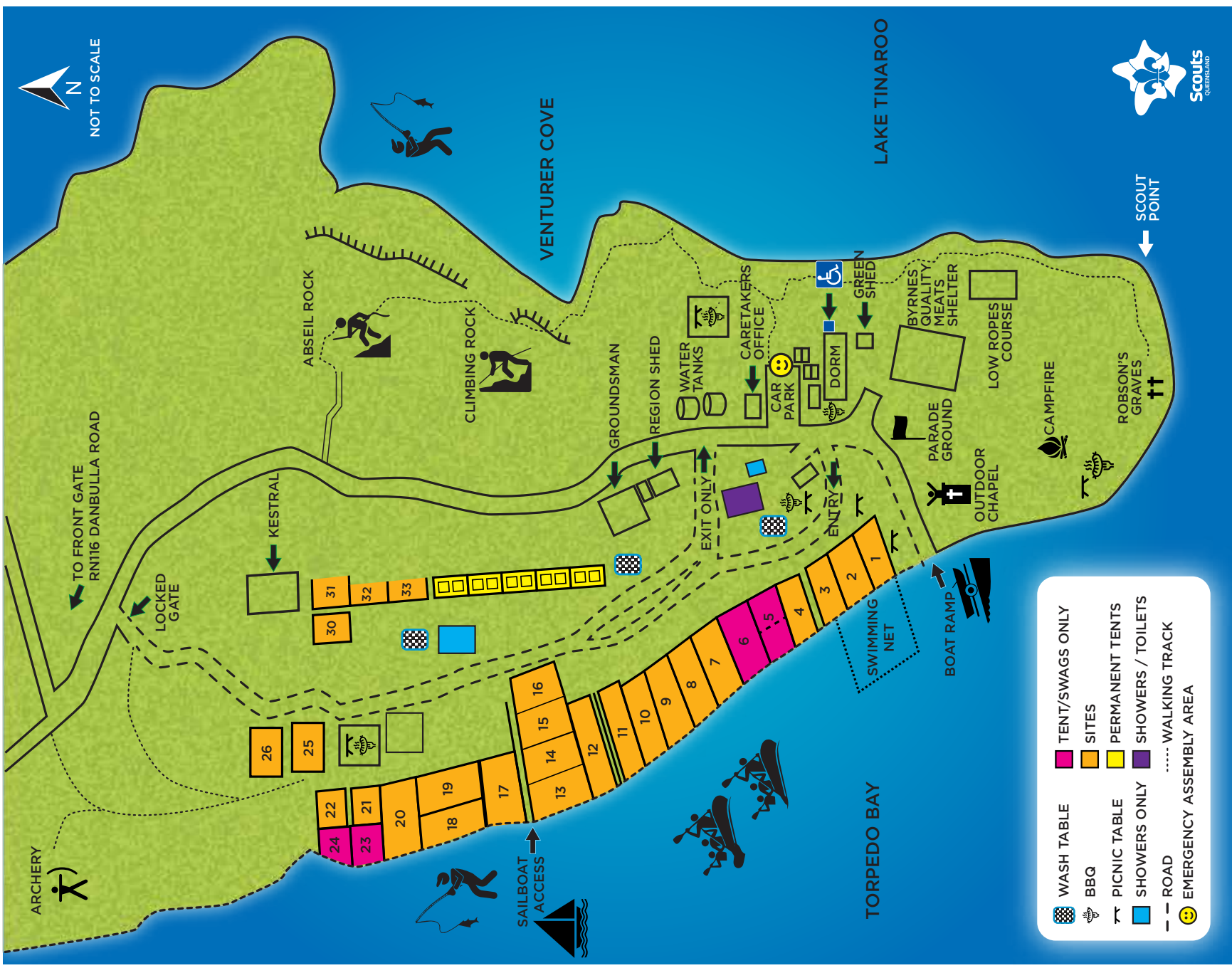
Canoes and powerboats to keep clear of flagged swimming area and must be a minimum of 30 mtrs from shore and/or swimmers and canoes. Canoes and sailboats have right of way always.
